

# How to create and glue the PanosFX Prism Calendar

for Adobe® Photoshop® and Adobe® Photoshop® Elements




**Desktop, prism-shaped calendar.**

A4 and US Letter sizes, 30 languages.  
Weeks starting on Monday or Sunday.  
Customizable colors, fonts, photos.  
Week numbers.

## 1. Load a PSD file

1.1. Double click the “LOAD A PRISM calendar PSD template” folder:




1.2. Load one of the 4 PSD templates:




## 2. Customize the calendar

2.1. Double click to open the “RUN ACTION to customize the calendar” folder:



2.2. Double click the “Customize the PRISM PanosFX calendar.atn” Action Set to load the actions in Photoshop:



2.3. Use the various actions to change the calendar language, add photos and customize the colors.

### 3. Print the calendar

Load a photo paper sheet (glossy or matte). Its weight should be between 200-300gsm.

Select **File > Print** from the menu.

NOTE: Do **not** check “**Scale to Fit Media**” in the Printer Settings window.

### 4. Fold and apply glue

There are 3 dashed lines on the printed prism calendar page, which look like the line below:

Carefully fold backwards along the dashed lines. You can use a **ruler** to fold precisely the paper along the lines.

The image on the right shows how the calendar should look like at this stage:



Here comes the last part. Apply a reasonable amount of glue onto the **gray area**, at the top edge of the paper (the gray stripe with the instructions). Glue it on the **lower edge** of the **back side of the sheet**, carefully aligning the edges.



You created a beautiful calendar that you can give away or use it at home or at the office.



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
