

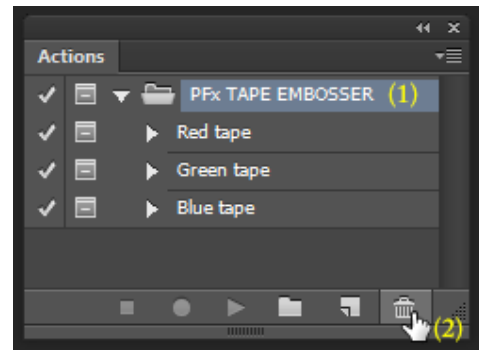
If you've downloaded a newer version of a particular set of Photoshop actions, it's recommended to unload the old version from Photoshop before loading the new one.

Here's a step-by-step guide on how to do it:

STEP 1: Unload the old version from the Actions Panel:

If the actions are loaded in the actions panel, please select the actions set **(1)**. Then, click on the panel's trash icon to unload it **(2)**.

Please be aware that this process won't delete the old file version of the actions from your hard disk; it will only unload them from Photoshop. To delete the files, please proceed to step 2.



STEP 2: Delete the old file version from your hard disk:

This step is optional. Locate the folder that contains the old action files. If you can't recall the location of the files, follow these steps to locate, select, and delete them:

- **Mac** users: Press *Ctrl-space* for Spotlight; enter a part of the Action Set name (e.g. TAPE EMBOSSE) and wait.

If you search for 'pfx' (pre-2021 versions) or 'panosfx' (from 2021 onwards) you'll discover all PanosFX add-ons in your hard disk.

When the search finishes, click 'Show all in Finder.'

- **Windows** users: Open File Explorer. Go to your hard disk's root directory (e.g., C:\), enter a part of the Action Set name (e.g. TAPE EMBOSSE) in the upper-right search box, press Enter and wait.

If you search for 'pfx' (pre-2021 versions) or 'panosfx' (from 2021 onwards) you'll discover all PanosFX add-ons in your hard disk.
